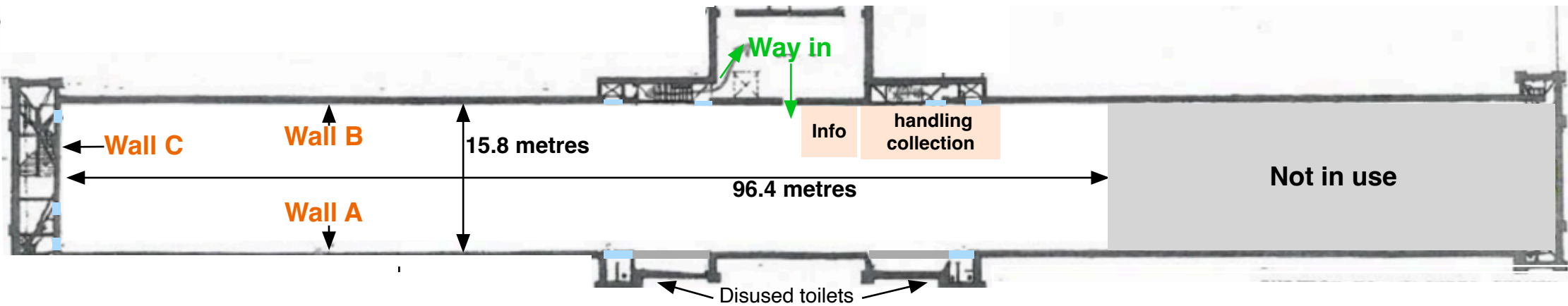




Salts Mill exhibition space floor plan, key and notes



Key to plan and section diagrams

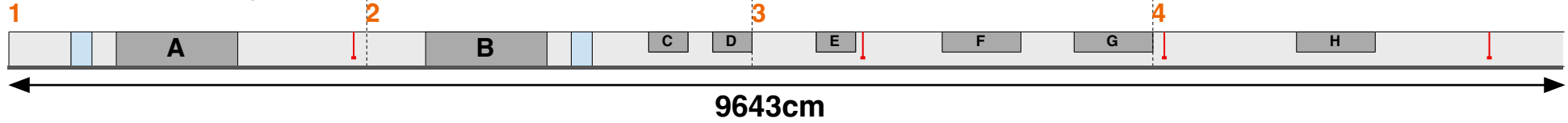
-  Walls
-  Grey painted panels 10mm deep MDF unless stated
-  Doors and lift doors (not all in use)
-  Areas allocated to handling collection, shop, information etc
-  Entrance to exhibition space
-  Electrical sockets (not tested and there may be a charge for use)

All measurements are approximate and not to scale, some are estimated

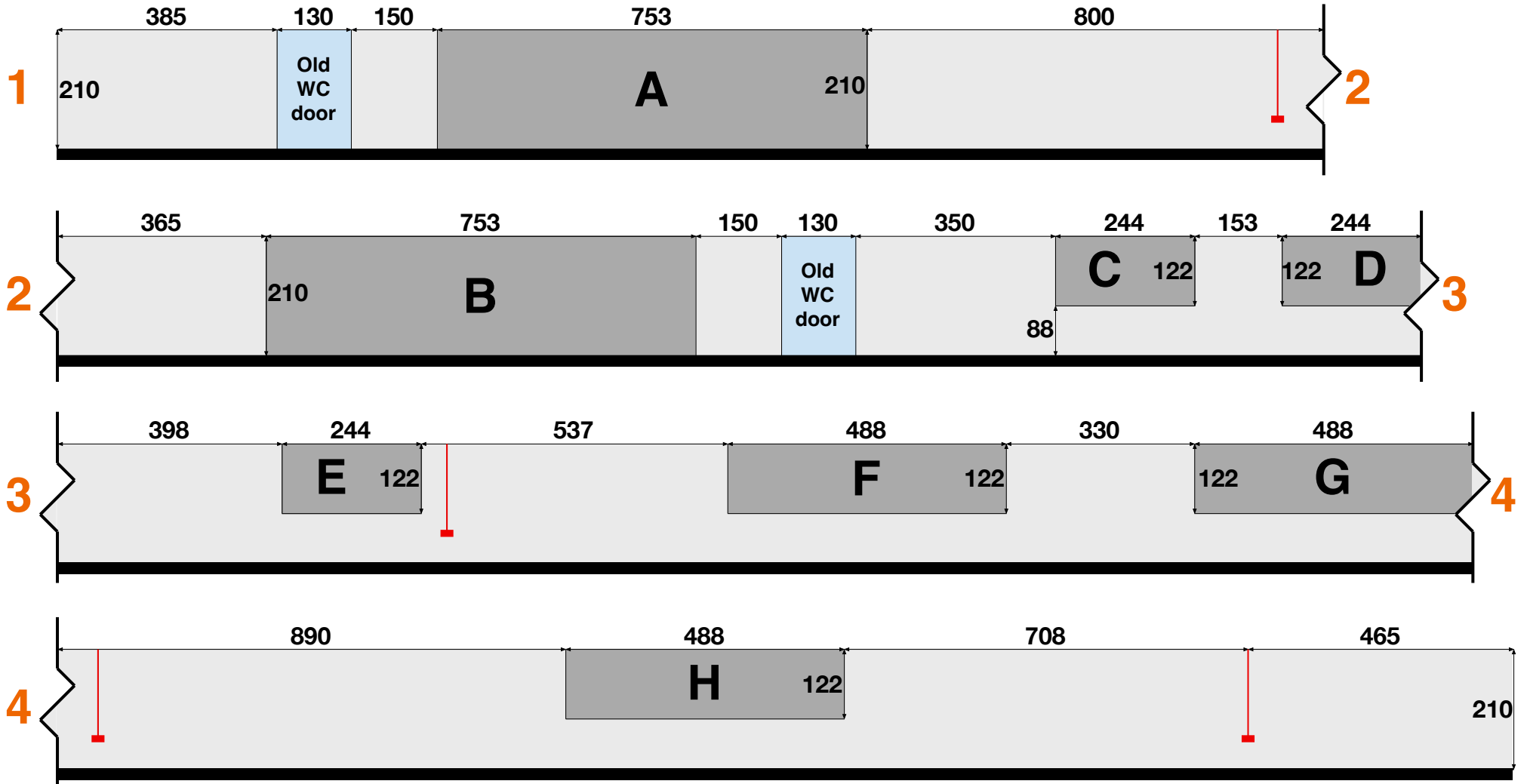

Wall A Entire length

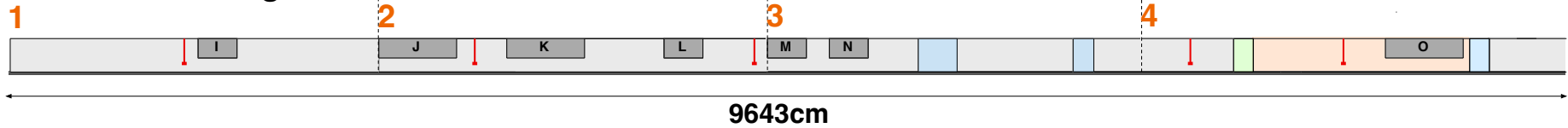


Sections of wall A with approximate measurements (all in centimetres)

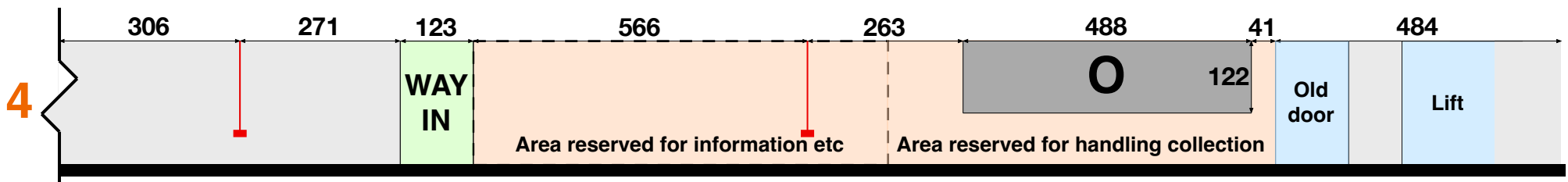
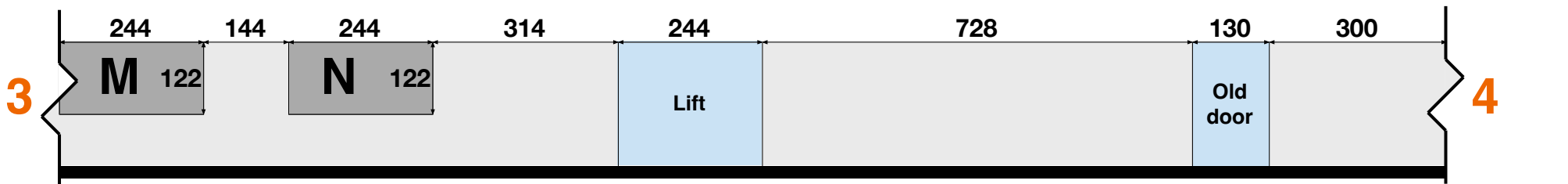
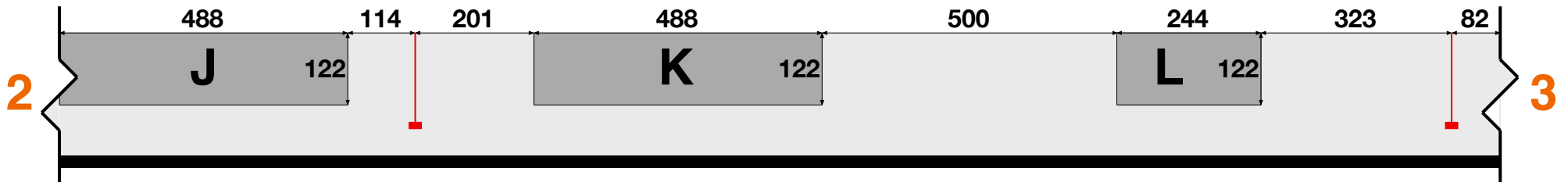
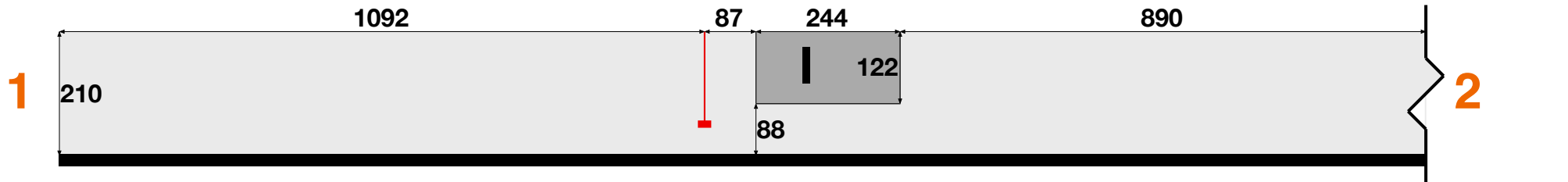


Salts Mill Wall B (Please refer to plan drawing for location and key)

Wall B Entire length

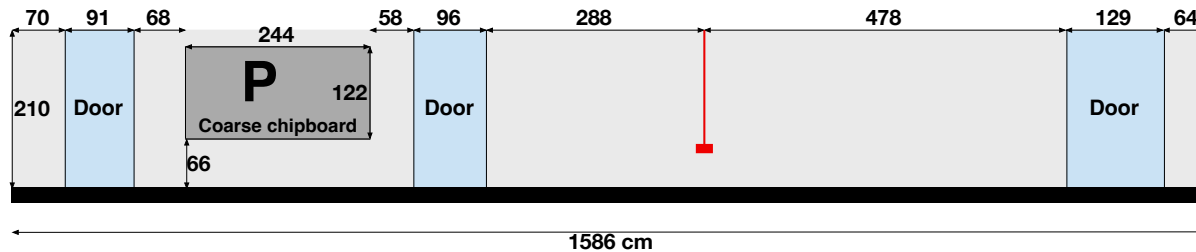


Sections of wall B with approximate measurements (all in centimetres)



Salts Mill Wall C (Please refer to plan drawing for location and key)

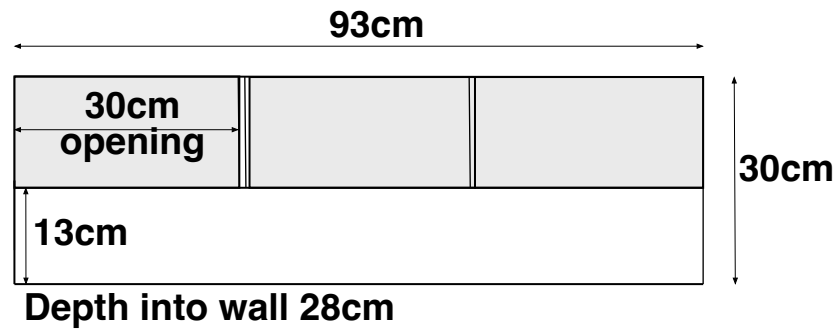
Wall C (End wall) Entire length and dimensions (*all in centimetres*)

Floor surface

The floor is made of stone slabs in a variety of sizes

Measurements of some typical sizes:

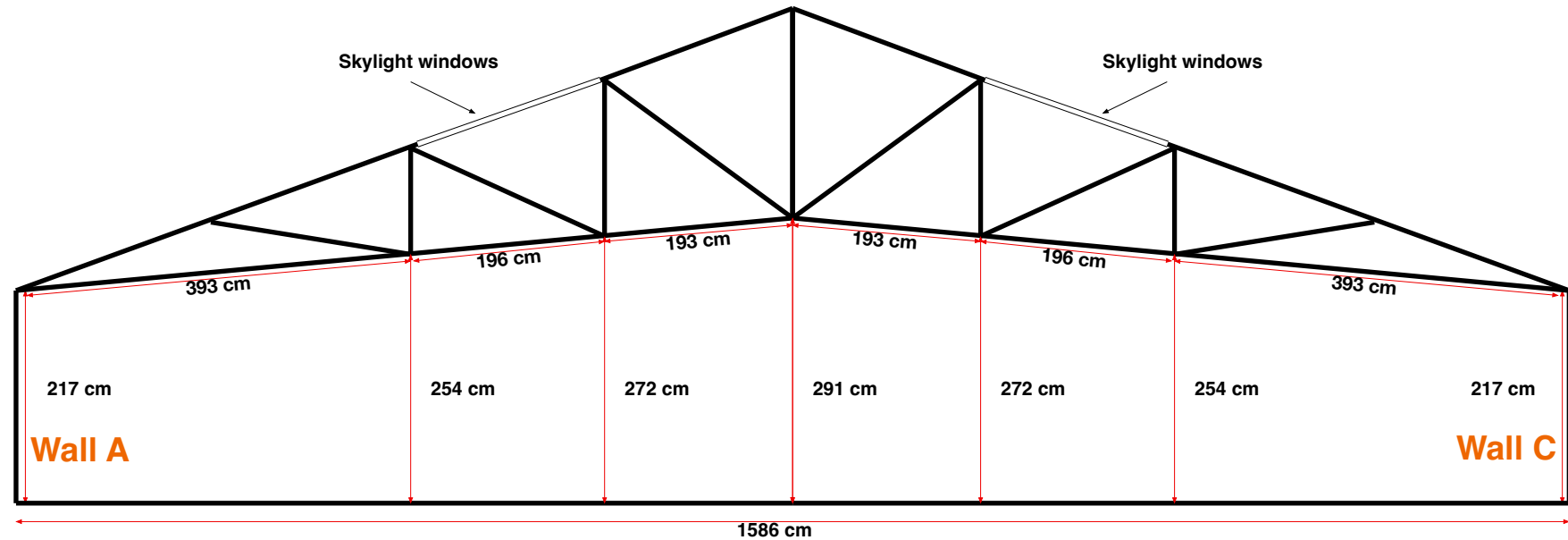
56 x 130 cm

Salts Mill roof truss approximate measurements



Notes

Total number of trusses in exhibition space: 39

Distance between each parallel truss structure approximately 247 cm

Lightweight items only can be hung from the bottom line of the trusses eg fabric sheet, paper

Please note that the bottom line of the trusses is slightly sloped up to the centre point

It appears that when it rains drips tend to gather at the bolted junction points of some of the trusses, so the area around and below them is more likely to get wet.
